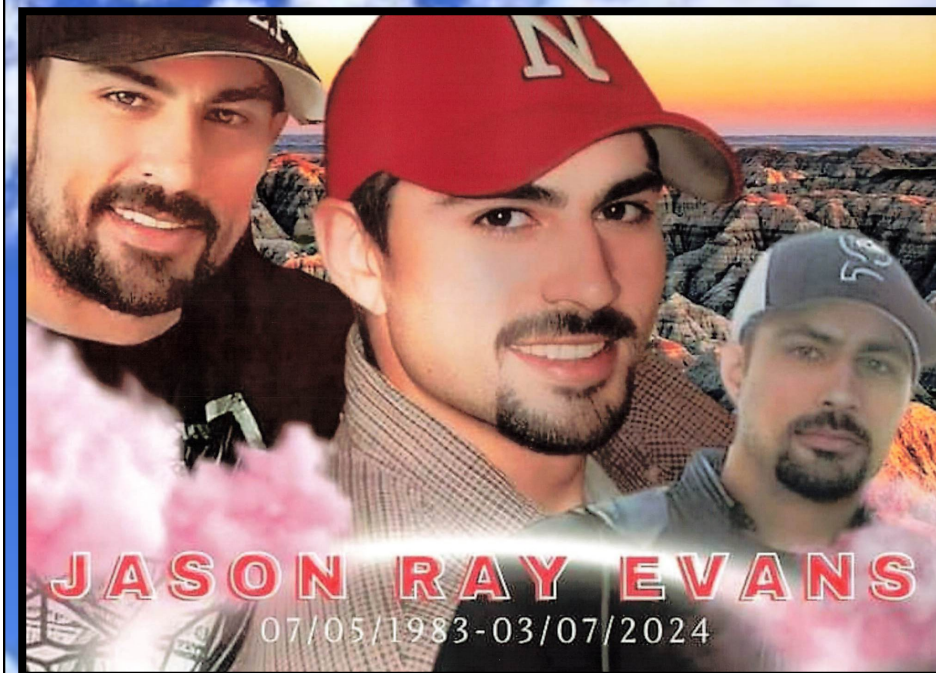
We may mourn the loss of Jason, but we also celebrate the enduring legacy of his life's journey. Let's keep the rubber burning and the memories turning.
