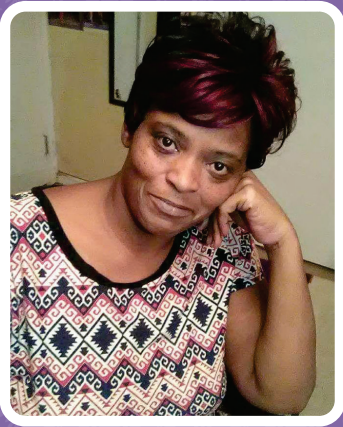
Dorothy attended Ozark City Schools, Ariton High School, and later received her GED.

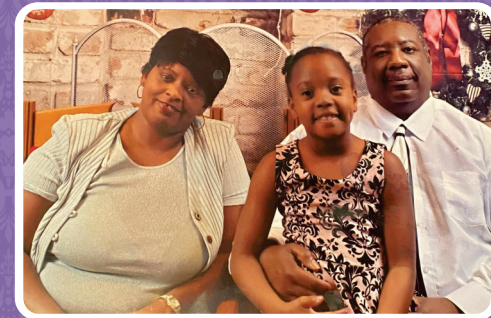
