I then most humbly **pray.**

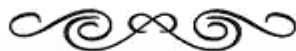

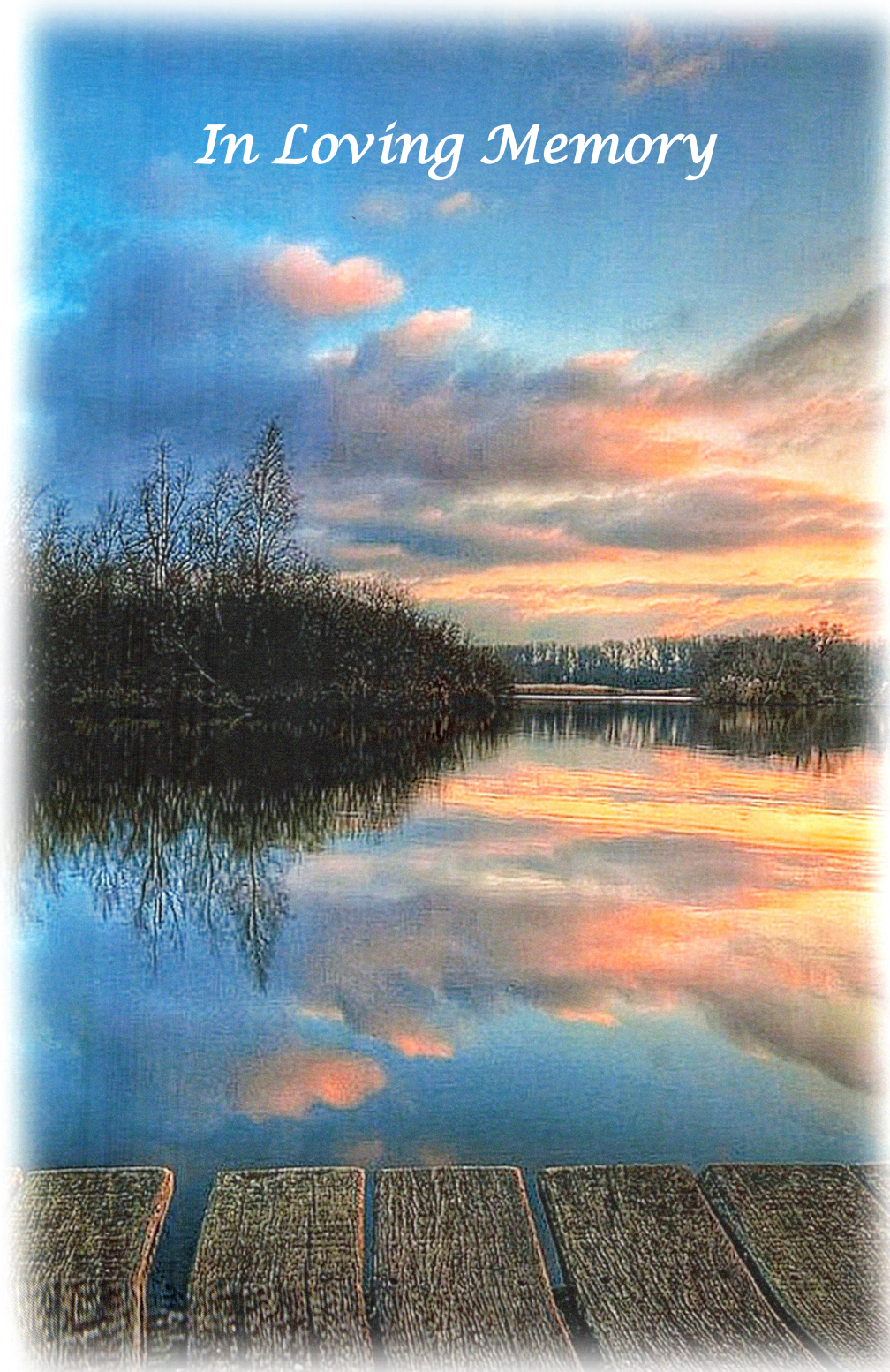

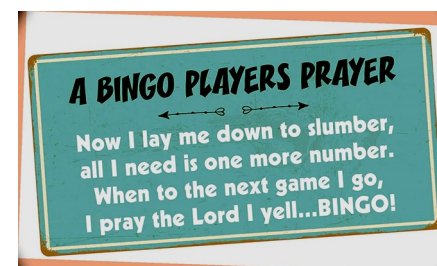
