Shirley was a member of the First United Methodist Church (now Faith Alive Church) for many years and served as the Sanctuary Seward for twenty of those years.

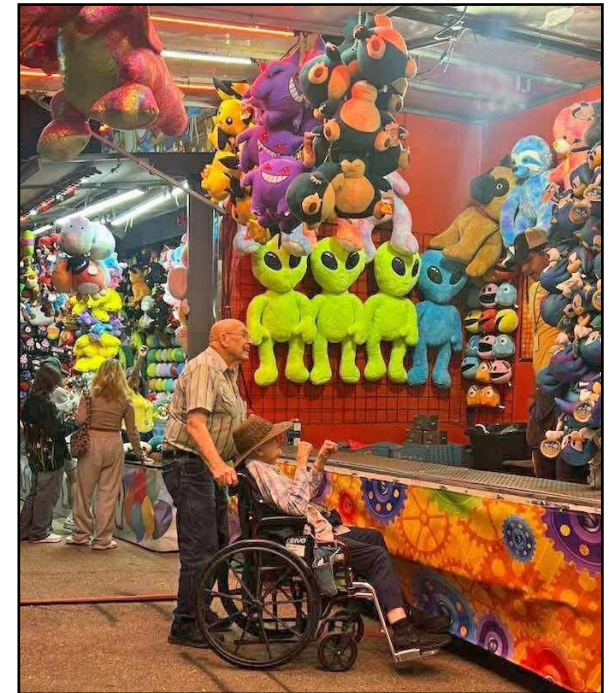
