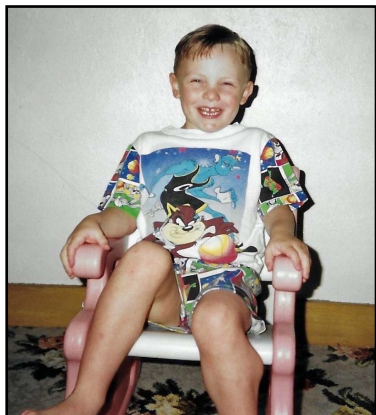

Josh grew up in Woonsocket, South Dakota and graduated high school there in May of 2012.

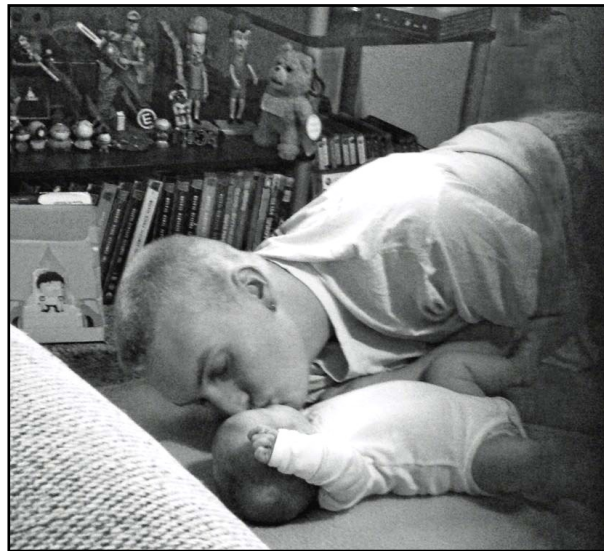


Josh was a jack of all trades and explored numerous jobs during his adult life. He enjoyed helping with construction, factory work, and being able to work alongside his friends.
