He retired as a Sergeant First Class from the United States Army in 1976. Ken was a hard worker with a strong work ethic who served his country on active duty for 20 years, including two tours in Vietnam.

Ken's favorite pastimes include studying family genealogy and playing billiards. In his younger days, Ken enjoyed hunting with family and friends. Most of all, Ken lived for his involvement in the VFW, American Legion, and especially the Forty and Eight. During his tenure serving in the Forty and Eight, Ken held various titles and positions within the organization. 
