I found the peace at the close of day.

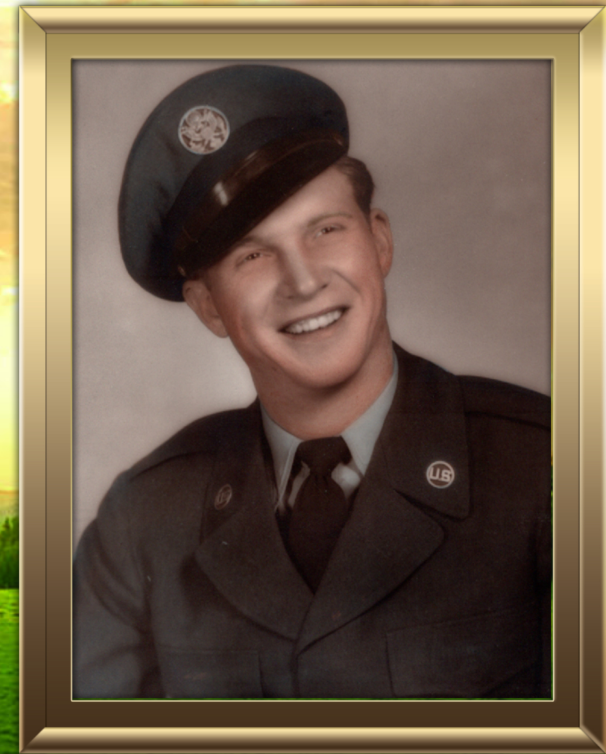
If my parting has left a void

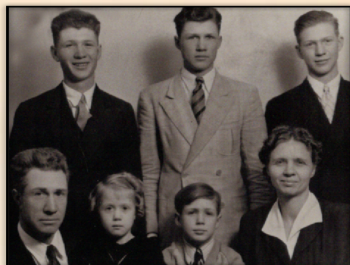
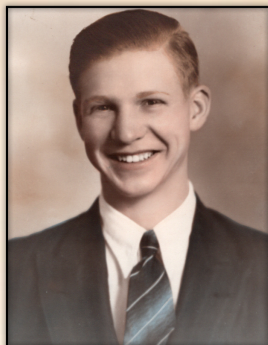
