Ivan Theodore Shonley was born November 7, 1923 at Hillside, SD, near Mitchell, SD, to Theodore and Lena Shonley. After 8th grade, he worked for his father as a carpenter. In 1943, he joined the US Navy and participated in the Seabees. In 1946, he returned home to South Dakota.

Ivan married Margaret Strand of rural Mitchell. They had one son, Douglas, and were divorced in 1956. Ivan married Dottie Ulmet in 1960. She preceded him in death December 26, 2014.

Ivan built many custom homes and commercial buildings in the Mitchell area. In 1976, he moved to the Black Hills and started a development in Boulder Canyon known as Boulder Park Subdivision. Later, he also developed more land that came to be known as Boulder Canyon Subdivision. Ivan had Alzheimer's the last ten years of his life.

Ivan, 91, Sturgis, died Thursday, March 5, 2015, at Sturgis Regional Hospital.
