Dementia took her mind, a horrible disease, robbing her family of so much. She will be kept alive in the memories she gave to those who loved her.

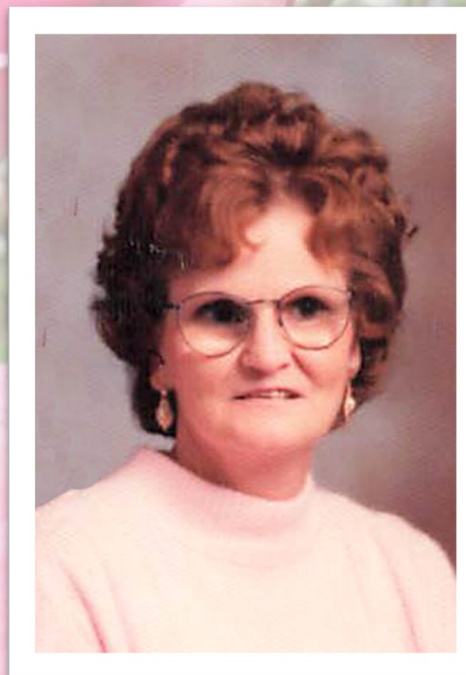
