She married Murray D. Miller on July 5, 1935, in Sturgis. They lived near Newell for two years then moved to the Sulphur area until the fall of 1945 when they moved to Sturgis where she has lived since. For many years, Helen was the bookkeeper for Key City Electric which she and Murray operated.

Helen was a member of the First Presbyterian Church where she served as a deacon. She was a Past President of the United Presbyterian Women and active in many church activities.
