Juan Fernandez Carrizales, 85, passed away Tuesday, June 18th, at home. Juan was born on March 26th, 1939, as the fourth of five children born to Ausencio and Maria Concepcion in Cerralvo, Nuevo Leon, Mexico. He married the love of his life, Jesusa, in 1964 and together they shared 60 years of marriage. Two months after their wedding, Juan, Jesusa, her parents, and five siblings made the move from Texas to Oregon.
