Charlesetta was known to all of her family and friends as “Chas.” Chas accepted Christ and was baptized at an early age at Macedonia Baptist Church under the pastoral leadership of Rev. Raymond Nash.

Charlesetta grew up in Okmulgee, OK where she attended Attucks Elementary School and the Historic Dunbar (Tigers) High School, Class of 1966.
