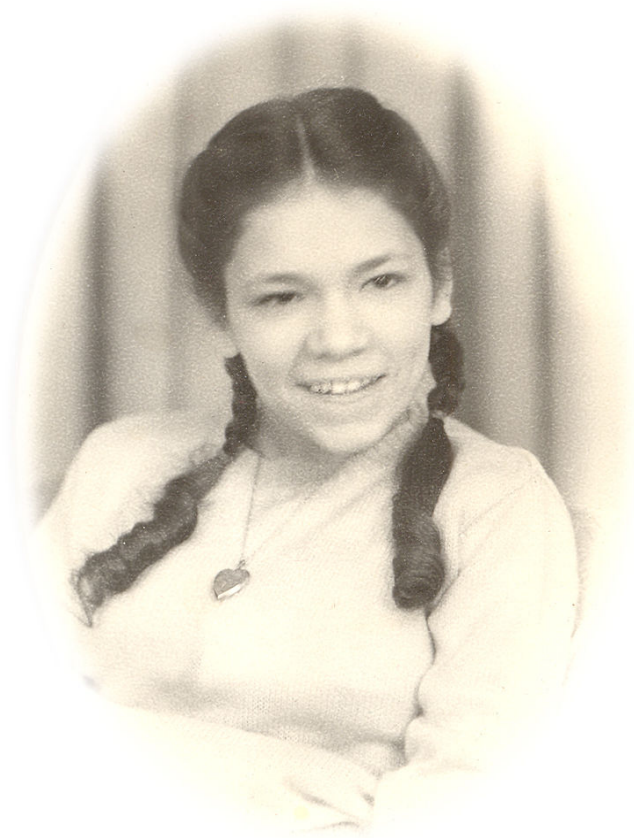
Norma Jean, 78, Sturgis, died Friday, August 19, 2011, at Sturgis Hospital.
