Footprints

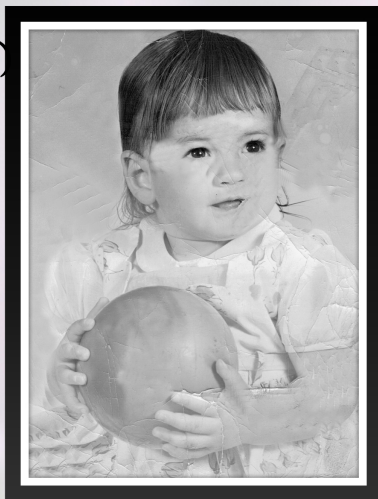
One night I had a dream.
