and where there is sadness, joy.

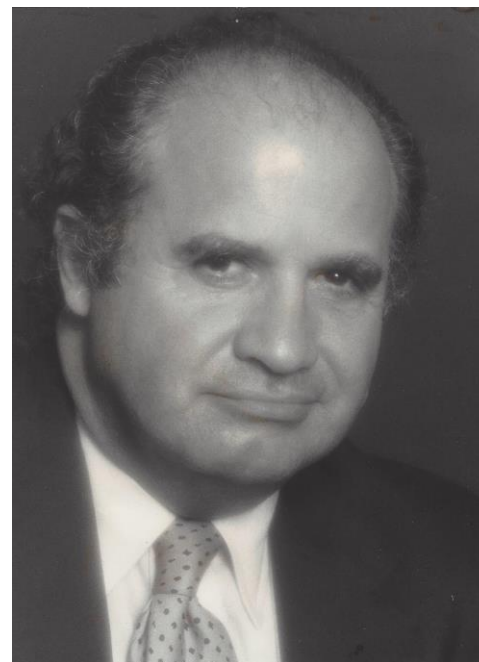
O Divine Master,
