life.

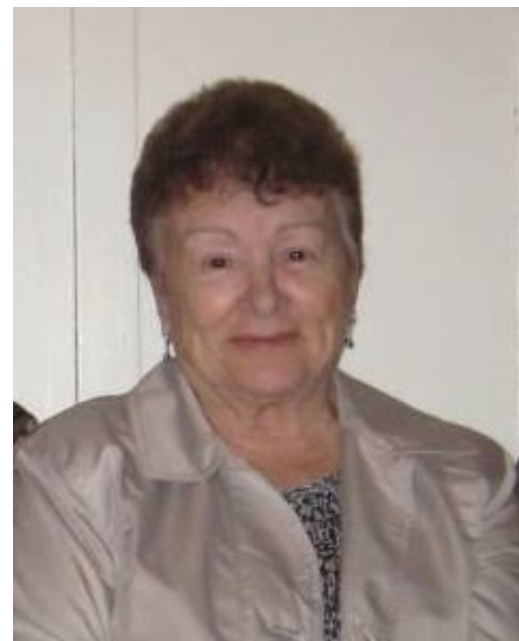
