

REVEREND GILES

Reverend Ralph Giles, Sr. was born on August 5, 1930, in Griffin, Georgia to the late Nathaniel and Doris Giles. Rev. Giles attended and graduated high school from Fairmont High School in Griffin, Georgia.

In his early years, Rev. Giles worked diligently at K-Mart for 15 years. Later in life, he became a CDL driver for 30 years throughout Atlanta, Georgia and surrounding counties.

Reverend Giles grew up serving at Mount Pleasant Baptist Church where he was a Junior Deacon and was later ordained as a Deacon prior to becoming an ordained minister. Rev. Giles was an ordained minister for 40 years. He lowed teaching and preaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and lowed to see souls added to the Body of Christ. He was also an associate minister at Mount Pleasant Baptist Church under the leadership and guidance of the late Rev. Horace Puller, Jr.
